## Annual Accounts/AGM



As you may remember from previous years, the end of the credit union financial year is 30 September. The year to September 2020 has been a very successful one in financial terms with the annual surplus increasing since last year despite COVID-19.

Normally the credit union holds the Annual General Meeting in a Dublin city centre hotel in December where up to 160 members might attend. This is not possible due to the pandemic, a situation shared with all the other credit unions. The Government has approved the general scheme of a bill to allow credit unions to postpone their AGMs until 30 April or to hold AGMs remotely. They hope to have the legislation enacted by the end of 2020. Further information will be passed on to members as it becomes available. As usual, full details on the performance of the credit union and information on the annual dividend/ loan interest rebate will be published in the annual report and circulated in advance of the AGM. Because of the delayed AGM, the annual accounts will be posted to the web site over the weeks ahead, in the interests of transparency.



# Autumn Home Improvement Loans
